- Headquarters Facility Services in Washington, DC
- Administration and Building Support in Merrifield, VA
- National Material Customer Service Center in Topeka, KS

All eligible employees will receive additional information about the incentive via First-Class Mail at their home address of record in the coming days. Employees should validate their address of record by visiting the "Employee Self-Service Application" in MyHR.
